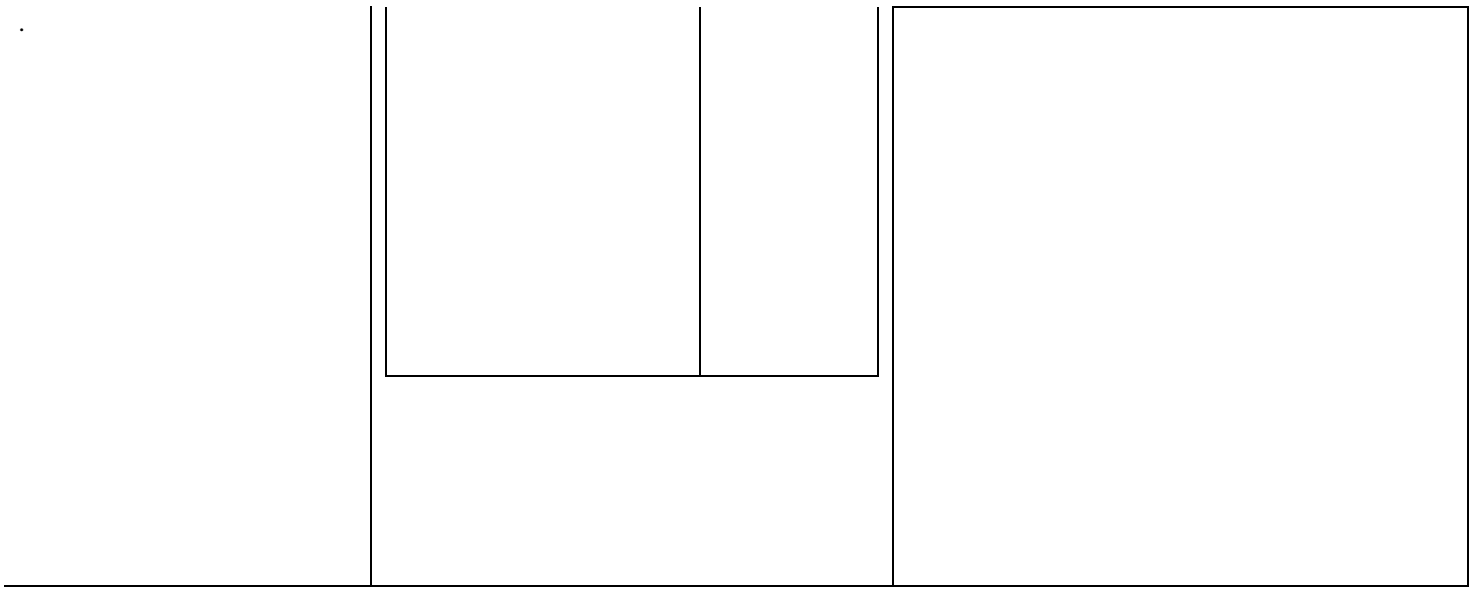
### OPEN DOOR POLICY
